Pentecost Special Offering in May...

The four Special Offerings of the PC(USA) are each connected to a season of the church year. These Offerings engage congregations in ministries of compassion, justice, Christian formation, education, peacemaking, and global witness. The Pentecost Offering is normally promoted and received on Pentecost Sunday. The Offering is divided into the following categories: 40% supports youth in your own church; 25% serves young adult volunteers; 25% supports ministries with youth; 10% provides advocacy that protects and nurtures children and youth. WEEKLY UPDATE FROM PSV COMMISSION CHAIRS AND PRESBYTERY LEADERS

As churches begin to cautiously consider re-opening to in-person worship and church activities, please keep in mind the presbytery's guidance - "The Least of These: Guidelines for Churches in a Pandemic" - which can be found here: https://psvresources.files.wordpress.com/2020/04/least-of-these.pdf

- Additionally, churches would be wise to abide by Ohio's official guidance for Consumer, Retail and Services: https://coronavirus.ohio.gov/static/responsible/Consumer-Retail-Services.pdf
- The Commission for Congregational Life (CCL) is happy to provide up to \$500 in reimbursements to any church that spends these funds on increase technology in order to continue to be a vibrant faith community during this pandemic. This grant program is a vouchered program, meaning churches must spend the money and

- then submit receipts to Adam Anderson, chair of CCL, for reimbursement. Any questions can be sent to Adam Anderson.
- The Presbytery is requesting that any church that receives funds from the Paycheck Protection Program to please report this to the Stated Clerk (statedclerk@psyonline.org) for recording keeping.
- The May Presbytery meeting at Broad Street PC has been cancelled; no make-up date is planned for currently.
- Speaking of Presbytery meetings, we are beginning to explore the logistics of holding a virtual presbytery meeting, should that be necessary. We are watching closely how General Assembly will run virtually and will borrow the best insights and practices from what we witness there for the sake of our own life together. As yet, no plans have been made one way or the other for the September Presbytery Meeting, but trust that the leadership is already considering these issues.
- The Discernment and Design AC that was created at the February 2020 Presbytery
 meeting is still being formed but do trust that this important work has not been
 sidelined by this global pandemic.
