Chris Roseland supports colleagues as they work with individuals, congregations and mid-councils across the United States. Chris came to the Presbyterian Mission Agency staff in 2009, bringing a wide-ranging experience gained through ministry in congregations and higher education. He has served congregations in Texas, Mississippi, and Kentucky as a youth and Christian education director, solo pastor, and head of staff.
