

Guidance to Congregations Considering Re-Opening Elder James A. Wilson, PSV Temporary Stated Clerk

As congregations consider returning to in-person worship or re-opening their buildings, Sessions must be mindful of both their legal and fiduciary duty to take reasonable steps to minimize the risk of spreading Covid-19 infections by worship or other church activities and their ordination vows to "watching over the people, providing for their worship, nurture, and service" (W-4.0404b) and "give[s] full expression to the rich diversity of the church's membership" (G-3.0103). This includes assessing whether a plan promotes expanding those who can worship or has the effect of excluding individuals whose risk factors prevent participation in in-person worship. In carrying out these obligations, we strongly urge Sessions to consider the following guidance for

Off Line Ministry Ideas for Christian Education

Hi educators! I hope that you have been able to enjoy some of this refreshing weather lately. I just attended a webinar on "Off Line Ministry Ideas" from Lifelong Learning at the Virginia Theological Seminary and thought that I would share some of the ideas:

- Themed car parades (back to school, meeting new staff, pet blessing)
- Mailing/Delivering to homes packets to set up worship space at home, or craft materials, or activity boxes, or a booklet of spiritual practices
- Having people write prayers on ribbons and tie them to the church handrails/fences/pillars (materials put in a real estate flier box outside church)
- Connect through handwritten notes for little ones include stickers; have youth write to children, or youth write to older adults, or older adults write to children; engage volunteers; do chain mails
- Have children draw pictures of something during worship and post them on $\ensuremath{\mathsf{FB}}$
- Virtual Talent Show and/or Art Show
- Collaborative art project families come to church at scheduled time OR send supplies home and put together
- Halloween ideas CARnival where kids can drive up and play a game from their car; drive through trunk or treat with candy at the end; Trek or Treat -

Scholarship and Grants Updates from the Synod of the Covenant

It's time to apply for the Synod's grants and higher education scholarships! We want to support the ministries of your churches and the academic work undertaken by your students.

The programs (and the dates when application reviews will begin) include:

1. Higher Education Scholarships, available to individual Presbyterians within the Synod who are attending college, university, trade school, or seminary/divinity school. Up to

- \$1500; 8/31/20.
- 2. COVID Emergency Need Grants for Higher Education Students. Up to \$500; 12/4/20.
- 3. New Covenant Grants, available to congregations, institutions, and organizations within the Synod for (a) congregational development and transformation, (b) multicultural and justice ministries, or (c) ministries in higher education. Up to \$5000; 10/1/20.
- 4. Racial Ethnic Program Grants, available to congregations primarily composed of Black, Indigenous, and People of Color (BIPOC) planning new mission initiatives or outreach to the neighborhoods surrounding their church. Up to \$5000; 10/1/20.

Each year the BOP sets a time for selecting benefits for the coming year. The Employer Agreements are now available on Benefits Connect at **pensions.org/2021benefits**.

The Board of Pensions has designed the Benefits Plan of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) so employers have the flexibility to choose from a variety of benefits options that best meet the needs of the organization and the employees. Once your church has signed their Employer Agreements, Open enrollment for benefits will run from October 26 to November 13. There are changes and new benefits that make it possible for churches to enroll their pastors who are not installed. The new *Minister's Choice* package, available in 2021, offers savings for non-installed ministers working at least 20 hours per week. Minister's Choice is a new benefits package that provides important financial protection for ministers. Coverage under the Minister's Choice Plan includes the Defined Benefit Pension Plan, Death and Disability Plan, Temporary Disability Plan, and Employee Assistance Plan. Minister's Choice also expands access to assistance and education programs now available only through Pastor's Participation. Employer cost for Minister's is 10 percent of effective salary.
