**A Presbyterian Gift...World Communion Sunday** (originally called World Wide Communion Sunday) is a gift of the Presbyterian Church to the larger ecumenical church. The first celebration occurred at Shadyside Presbyterian Church in Pittsburgh, PA, in 1933 where Dr. Hugh Thompson Kerr served as pastor. Celebration of World Wide Communion Sunday was adopted as a denominational practice in the

Presbyterian Church (US) in 1936. Churches in other denominations were invited to celebrate with us from the beginning, but it wasn't until 1940 when the Department of Evangelism of the Federal Council of Churches (a predecessor body of the National Council of Churches) promoted extending the celebration to a number of churches around the world that the practice became widespread. Today, World Communion Sunday is celebrated around the world.

# A Call to Awareness and Response by Reverend Ann Palmerton, Associate Pastor, Columbus Broad Street Presbyterian Church...

Victims of domestic violence tell others how abuse affects them physically, mentally and spiritually. At LSS CHOICES and The Center for Family Safety and Healing, faith can be a source of strength and guidance for victims, an important part of their identity and community, and an essential element in decision making and healing. Many victims turn to their faith for support when faced with abuse. You may see this in your congregations.

Your help is needed in addressing the spiritual needs of survivors of abuse. As a faith leader, you can play a unique and important role in helping victims.

Safe Havens offers an online learning opportunity for local faith leaders that will take place over the course of three sessions in October. <u>Safe Havens</u> is a group of faith leaders who believe that every congregation can be a safe haven for victims of domestic violence. They have facilitated this event in more than 25 communities across the United States, and the feedback from faith leaders has been very positive.

This very important conference will give an opportunity to learn about the trauma that victims experience and the ways we can work together to help people in Franklin County stay safe.

#### The PC (USA) Board of Pensions Ministers' Choice Plan

Each year the PCUSA Board of Pensions (BOP) sets a time for selecting benefits for the coming year. The Employer Agreements are available on Benefits Connect at: **pensions.org/2021benefits**. Once the church has signed their Employer Agreements, open enrollment for benefits will run from October 26 to November 13. There are changes and new benefits that make it possible for churches to enroll their pastors who are not installed. The new *Minister's Choice* package, available in 2021, offers savings for non-installed ministers working at least 20 hours per week. Minister's Choice is a new benefits package that provides important financial protection for ministers. Coverage under the Minister's Choice Plan includes the Defined Benefit Pension Plan, Death and Disability Plan, Temporary Disability Plan, and Employee Assistance Plan.
