Per Capita Relief Policy

Elder Jim Hines, Chair PSV Commission for Presbytery Operations (This policy is to grant relief to congregations that have experienced a 10% or more loss of membership from last year.) **HOW THE POLICY WORKS** – Historically, a congregation's per capita for the coming year is based on their membership at the end of the previous year. For example, a churches' per capita for **2021** would normally be based on their membership at the end of **2019** – NOT their membership at the end of 2020. Under this "relief policy", the Presbytery will grant immediate relief to any congregation who has experienced a 10% or more loss of membership during 2020 and will base 2021's per capita on your year 2020 membership. If you have had a significant loss of membership in 2020, you can apply for relief under this policy and your 2021 per capita will be based on your year-end membership as of 2020 – not 2019 as under the current policy.

If you want to request relief under this new policy, please email either Bob Gustafson, Temporary Treasurer; John Wyckoff, Financial Assistant; or Dagmar Romage, Administrative Assistant. This relief will not be automatic.

Virtual "At Home" Sunday School for children (and

families) Jenni Whitford, Educator, Worthington Presbyterian Church Beginning last September, Worthington Presbyterian Church (WPC) has been offering TWO "At Home" Sunday School options for K-6th graders. The curriculum we are using is "Growing in God's Love" A Story Bible Curriculum (PCUSA) <u>https://www.pcusastore.com/Pages/Item/13638/Story-Bible-</u> <u>Curriculum.aspx</u>



The Director of Children's Ministry records a 15-minute video with song, prayer, Bible story, wonder questions and a short activity. Parents can add to the lesson with "At Home" supplemental activities, ideas and book and video recommendations, which are emailed to the families each week. Families can watch the video alone, just do the "At Home" lesson or do both pieces. Families can do one thing one week and a different thing next week. Families can do Sunday School on a Tuesday night or a Friday afternoon....whenever it works best for their family. Each week is a stand-alone lesson, you do not have to do the lesson before.

The curriculum has 35 Units, each unit has 3-5 lessons. Lessons are well written; with lots of choices for activities and suggestions to dive deeper or add more to each lesson, such as books to check out from your local library to short YouTube videos to expand the learner's knowledge. The lessons are multi-age: pre-readers to tweens will learn, have fun and be challenged in age-appropriate activities, questions and discussion starters.

Each family received a copy of "Growing in God's Love" Story Bible. (When you buy 25 or more copies, the price drops to about \$13 each) This was the biggest investment we made. We thought it was worth it, as we weren't (and still aren't) meeting in person. Each unit is \$35-\$40, or about \$8/week. We ordered everything digitally – we hope to use this curriculum again in about 4 years, which will make it even more cost efficient. When we do start meeting again in person, we will continue to use this curriculum, the lessons have several activities each week that we have not been offering, as they are designed for group projects or require supplies such as paint, mural making, poster board or puppets.

News from the Covenant Presbyterian Church

On January 11, 2021, the Reverend Joel Alan Esala starts his call as Senior Pastor of Covenant Presbyterian Church in Upper Arlington, Ohio. Reverend Esala, his spouse Sarah, and his son Asher now reside in Dublin, Ohio. Pastor Joel was ordained in 2016 and received his BA from the Ohio State University, a Master of Theology from Princeton Theological Seminary, and Masters of Divinity from the Reformed Theological Seminary in Orlando.

Prior to the call to Covenant, Joel was the solo Pastor at Circleville Presbyterian Church, Associate Pastor at Central College Presbyterian Church and Associate Pastor at Heritage Christian Church both in Westerville, Ohio. He also served as Director of Youth and Family Ministries at Trinity Episcopal Church in Solebury, Pennsylvania. Joel was selected from a field of more than 250 inquiries of which 48 were carefully reviewed and 4 finalists from around the country were interviewed. Throughout the selection process, Covenant and Joel were guided by God's hands that brought them together. Covenant was interested in calling a pastor like Joel who is committed to excellent worship, creative and innovative mission, and outreach to a diverse congregation.
