Higher Education Scholarships for Christian Leaders Award Winners

The Synod of the Covenant is delighted to announce that it has awarded almost \$40,000 in scholarships to 56 students from 10 presbyteries and 29 churches. These awards, ranging

from \$500 to \$1,000, go to the winners of the Higher Education Scholarships for Christian Leaders.

These scholarships include 45 bachelor degrees, 4 associate degrees, and 7 theology scholarships. Of the 56 scholarships 27 were given to people who self-identified as Black, Korean, Asian, and African. This year, in addition to articulating their career goals, applicants also reflected on how they work toward building congregational vitality, dismantling structural racism, and/or eradicating systemic poverty. These areas of ministry characterize the Matthew 25 movement within the Presbyterian Church (USA), of which the Synod of the Covenant is a part.

These Higher Education scholarships are funded in part by per capita payments from the almost 700 Presbyterian Church (USA) congregations and more than 100,000 members, mostly in the states of Ohio and Michigan, throughout the Synod of the Covenant.

CDC Guidelines - Covid Update

Current CDC guidelines are changing for places with more than 50 new cases per 100,000; most of those are in the south and southwest but include every major city you can name. You can see the map here: https://covid.cdc.gov/covid-data-tracker/#county-view

The CDC director has suggested that even vaccinated people in hard-hit places and crowded environments should consider going back to wearing masks. While reported breakthrough levels are still low (5914 out of 161Million people vaccinated), and transmission by vaccinated people also low, asymptomatic infection and transmission is still possible. It's the unvaccinated people at are significant risk and who are carrying the pandemic forward. Here's the chilling stat: 50% of ALL COUNTIES across the entire US are at the highest risk level for community transmission, and another 17% are at "substantial" risk. Less than 9% are at low risk. And the level of community transmission is increasing by about 18% currently.

This came across my news feed from a physician as part of the "top 5 places not to go" – rated #3:

3. Avoid Churches or Places of Worship

Delta spreads quickly and these places provide the perfect situation for it to spread. Usually poorly ventilated the danger is increased because folks speak, sing, and sometimes shout. If they are carriers of the Delta coronavirus, you are likely going to catch it. If you catch it, you will bring the virus home with you. These gatherings are also less likely to have adequate physical separation and inadequate ventilation.

Please – a personal plea from me as Lisa, not as Presbyter: Get Vaccinated and encourage others to do the same. This is the only way we will beat COVID. Stay safe. And show Extreme Grace to those who don't believe what you believe. The Kingdom needs you.


