Per Capita and Mission Giving Update

from Robert Patterson, Presbytery of Scioto Valley (PSV) Treasurer

Per Capita and Mission Giving represent the primary way the PC(USA) churches support the mission of our Presbytery, Synod and General Assembly. The Presbytery approved continuing the Per Capita for 2022 at \$40.00 per member. Each church's total Per Capita is calculated on the number of members on the church roll as of December 31, 2020, as reported through the annual Statistical Report.

The 2022 Per Capita is distributed as follows: Presbytery of Scioto Valley, \$27.80; Synod of the Covenant - \$3.25; General Assembly, \$8.95. Congregational Mission Giving supports ministries in the Presbytery and throughout the denomination. Mission support giving level is at the discretion of the congregation. Unless otherwise specified by the congregation the dollars will be divided as follows: Scioto Valley Presbytery 67%, General Assembly (PCUSA) 32%, Synod of the Covenant 1%. Columbus Brookwood Presbyterian Church Building Sold and the Site will be Senior Housing. News From the Columbus Dispatch USA TODAY NETWORK

The Brookwood Presbyterian Church site on East Livingston Avenue on Columbus' near east area will soon become home to a 103 unit independent senior living facility. Plans are underway to construct the facility with one- and two- bedroom rental units at 2685 E. Livingston Ave. When it likely opens in the fall of 2023, Tradition at Brookwood will be managed by National Church Residences, one of the country's largest nonprofit owners and operators of senior affordable housing, with campuses in 25 states. Traditions at Brookwood will be a mixed-income facility for those age 55 and older, with 26 affordable housing units and 77 market-rate units. National Church Residences plans to save and incorporate into the facility several architectural features of the church — including the cross from its chapel and stained-glass windows — to pay homage to its long history within the community.

The Presbytery of Scioto Valley includes 87 churches with a membership of 13,520 (updated March 23, 2021). Surrounding the metropolitan center of Columbus, Ohio, the Presbytery extends northward to Marion, east to Newark, west to London and southward to the Ohio River. The southern portion of the presbytery is distinguished by an Appalachian culture, where there are many small towns and much rugged open country. Scioto Valley Presbytery is represented in 21 Counties: Athens,



Delaware, Fairfield, Fayette, Franklin, Gallia, Hocking, Jackson, Knox, Lawrence, Licking, Madison, Marion, Meigs, Morrow, Pickaway, Pike, Ross, Scioto, Union, and Vinton.
