WHAT IS THE SELF-DEVELOPMENT of PEOPLE COMMUNITY GRANT? The Self-Development of People (SDOP) program of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) provides small "start-up" grants to informal community groups of seven or more

members. Grants may range up to \$2000. SDOP grants are designed grant to informal community group of seven or more for groups whose members are financially underserved and function as self-governing units seeking to improve their own well-being and empowerment.




