Lighting of the Advent Wreath

Today is the fourth Sunday of Advent. Advent is a time of waiting and preparation. Each week, as we have lit the candles on our Advent wreath, we have been reminded that the Light of the World, our Lord Jesus Christ is coming.

(Light 4 Candles)

We light the first candle, the candle of hope, to remind us of prophets who give us visions of hope. The second candle, the candle of peace, helps us remember that God is always with us. The third candle is the candle of joy. It reminds us of the angels' joy as they announced the news of Jesus' birth to the shepherds.

Today we light the fourth candle as a symbol of God's love for us and our love for one another. For the Lord rejoices over us with gladness, and renews us in his love. He exults over us with singing and turns our sadness into praise. We love because God first loved us.

Prayer:

O God, we thank you for all of those people that have been set in our lives to show us your love. May we in turn share your love with others. As we journey through Advent, prepare our hearts to be **t**ransformed by you, that we may walk in your light as we seek hope, peace, joy and love. Come Lord, Jesus come. Amen.
