Dear WPC Family,

You will find this newsletter contains a lot of important information. As you read through it, you will notice that the church has been a very busy place. The Pandemic may have pushed us out of the building for a while, but God has been at work throughout this time and hopefully this newsletter will reflect that fact. Many ministries and groups are gearing up again with more in-person meetings. A walk through the church building shows much hard work by staff and church volunteers in preparing for a full return to the building. Things are being cleaned, organized and updated in ways that show we are very much an active, vibrant community of faith.

One of the biggest changes you will see is in the Education wing. Beginning in September, the Westminster Presbyterian Church Preschool will fill those rooms with dozens of children and will provide a wonderful opportunity for us to share a Christlike welcome to them and their families.

The session has voted to incorporate the preschool into the ministry and mission of the church. We will share in ministry and outreach to both the preschool/church families and our greater community.

Each week, the preschoolers will attend chapel led by the pastors and other church volunteers. Children will learn Bible Stories, prayers, and songs all while being surrounded by God's love.

The preschool itself is a school readiness program with the education and nurturing of young children at its core.

We will also have ample opportunities for outreach to the children and their families who attend the preschool. They will be invited into the life of the church—especially those ministries that have a focus on young families: Vacation Bible School, Trunk or Treat, Advent Festival, etc.

We also envision an element of outreach and mission to the community. For example, the church and the preschool community together can participate in service projects such as collecting items for local missions we support.

We will invite the families to attend worship and hope to have a "Preschool Sunday" where the preschoolers will sing in worship and participate in other ways.

The WPC Preschool is a wonderful outreach ministry of our church. It is true evangelism—a way for all of us to spread God's love and welcome others into our community.

Let us give all glory and praise to God for all these many blessings even in the midst of such a challenging time.

Some elves have been busy refreshing the Book Room. Books are still available to purchase, however, we have sorted and donated the much older ones. This room is also great space for a small group meeting (6-8 people). We hope you will stop by the church and check out the new and improved Book Room.

MEMORIAL CROSS WALL IN WPC

We are happy to tell you about a new ministry of $\overline{WPC-a}$ Memorial Cross Wall which will be located in the hallway before reaching the South X. This will become a sacred space in the church as we remember loved ones who have died- A remembrance of Saints. This will be an ongoing ministry of the church. Here are some guidelines about the Cross Wall:

1. The crosses are not just for church members-you may have a cross hung for a parent(s), siblings, spouses, loved ones. The person may have died many years ago or recently.

2. Please make sure crosses are easy for us to hang and no bigger than 18 inches. You get to pick and purchase your own cross.

3. There are 4 of us who will be hanging the crosses and we will be writing in a memorial book which will be in the hallway. Each cross will be assigned a number and this number will be on the back of the cross. The number will coincide with the same number in the memorial book so folks can read the memorial about the cross.

4. If you would like to bring a cross to be hung on the Memorial Wall please bring it to the church office with your name on it. Also, include what you would like written in the book. Some examples would be: In memory of my husband, Kenneth, from Ruby McLeland. Or: In loving memory of my parents, Bess and Frank Hunt, given by Jane Hunt.

Please remember that we will be hanging the crosses and we will be writing in the Memorial Book. This will keep our Cross Wall organized. You may start to bring crosses in August and we will start hanging them soon after. If you have any questions please contact one of us. We have included pictures so you don't even have to imagine how the cross wall will look.
