

Gatekeepers Workcamp is a ministry of a consortium of churches in Rocky Mount, NC with work "headquartered" at Lakeside Baptist. The Mission of Gatekeepers Workcamp is to provide hands-on, Christian mission experience for youth in grades 6-12 in an ecumenical setting and to provide free home repairs for homeowners who are unable to maintain their homes because of financial or physical limitations. Adult volunteers are needed to assist with this mission. Volunteers are needed to help with the daily lunches provided at Church of the Good Shepherd as well as skilled labor in the homes while supervising the youth. 
