### Minutes: Stated Meeting, First Presbyterian Church, Maysville, KY

August 12, 2017

### Convening of Presbytery

The stated meeting of the Presbytery of Transylvania met at First Presbyterian Church, Maysville, KY, on Saturday, August 12, 2017. A quorum was present. Moderator Beth Garrod-Logsdon called the meeting to order at 10:05 AM and the Presbytery opened with a worship service of Word and Sacrament led by the Rev. Dr. Ann Philbrick and other leaders.

### Opening Business

The roll of attendance for this meeting was formed. (see Appendix A) The Rev. Dr. Ann Philbrick of National Capital Presbytery was welcomed and enrolled as a corresponding member.

### Summary attendance:

Teaching elders Present: 45; Teaching Elders Excused: 12; Teaching Elders Absent: 21; Churches with Elder Commissioner(s) Present: 24; Churches with Elder Commissioner(s) Absent: 53; Commissioned Ruling Elders Present: 5; Coordinating Commission members Present: 4; Presbytery Staff: 2; Visitors Present: 10.

The Stated Clerk moved the docket, which was approved. First-time commissioners and other guests were recognized. General Presbyter Philip Lotspeich informed the body of teaching elders who have left the presbytery and/or taken new calls. Commissioned Ruling Elder James Dougans brought greetings from the host church and a presentation on the history of the Maysville Church.

The Stated Clerk moved the consent agenda: a) Stated Clerk's report, with recommendations to approve requests for excused absences; approve the minutes of the March 14, 2017, stated meeting; approve minutes of the installation commission of the Rev. Linda Maconochie on April 2, 2017; approve minutes of the installation commission of the Rev. Wanda Olive on June 25, 2017; b) Commission on Congregational Issues report; c) Commission on Preparation for Ministry report. Motion passed.

### Decision Agenda

### **Burnamwood Report**

Camp Director Robby Lear reported. The director provided a report for the camping season just ended and his belief that things are moving in a good direction. Fall

retreats were publicized and hand-outs distributed. Mr. Lear shared news of the hiring of Kevin Turpin as new camp grounds caretaker and shared with the Presbytery proposed plans to upgrade camp facilities. The director encouraged the body to support the camp and send youth to the various events.

### **Recognizing Retirements**

The moderator honored and recognized the retirements of teaching elders Ellen Peach and James Stewart. At 12:00 PM, the moderator declared a recess for lunch and the body reassembled at 1:05 PM.

### **Coordinating Commission**

Chair Peggy Tudor reported. The Coordinating Commission recommended that the Manual of Operations be changed to add this description for the Closing Commission. "The Closing Commission shall counsel with congregations that have indicated their desire to end their relationship with the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) or those that have reached the completion of their effective ministry. This commission shall receive referrals from the Presbytery, the Commission on Congregational Issues or the Coordinating Commission. This commission shall determine a course of action, either division, dismissal, or dissolution, negotiate the terms of such action, and recommend it to the Presbytery for final approval. Such negotiations include consultation with the Administration (Trustees) Commission." Motion passed.

The Coordinating Commission recommended the formation of a new ministry, Church Revitalization and Development, and that the Manual of Operations be changed to include this description. "The Church Revitalization and Development Ministry exists to work with current churches engaging in revitalization and transformation efforts and to promote and encourage the development of new worshiping communities." Motion passed.

#### **Pastoral Transitions Commission**

Chair Lisa Eye and Vice-Chair Daryl Baker reported. Ms. Eye reported on churches in transition and changes to pastoral calls (see written report). The report was updated verbally to include dissolutions of pastoral calls to teaching elder Jason Santalucia effective June 25, 2017; teaching elder Woody Berry effective July 1, 2017; and teaching elder James Stewart effective September 1, 2017. The printed report was further updated verbally to inform the body that permission had been granted to the First Presbyterian Church, Mount Sterling, to form a pastor nominating committee.

Mr. Baker called to the body's attention to the proposed minimum terms of call for 2018 and took questions from the floor. The recommendations will be brought in final form to the Presbytery's meeting in November for approval.

### Presbyterian Women

Moderator Nell Line reported. Ms. Line informed the Presbytery of recent PW events, including the Spring Gathering and the July Women's conference. The Fall Gathering will take place at Camp Burnamwood on October 21, 2017 and Ms. Line encouraged all women to attend. The next national gathering of Presbyterian Women will take place in August, 2018.

### Administration/Treasurer's Report

Presbytery Treasurer Catesby reported. Financial information was provided as part of the Presbytery packet, as well as actions taken by the Administration Commission since the last Presbytery meeting.

### **Commission on Representation**

Chair Janet Prewitt reported. The Commission on Representation placed these names in nomination for election as delegates to the 2017 meeting of the Kentucky Council of Churches: Mike Ward, teaching elder, Walnut Hill; Dr. Elizabeth Underwood, ruling elder, FPC Richmond; Mr. Hank Graddy, ruling elder, Pisgah Versailles; teaching elder Susan Warren, honorably retired; Mr. Lawrence Monroe, ruling elder, FPC Hazard. There were no nominations from the floor and those named were so elected.

### **General Presbyter**

Philip Lotspeich shared words of thanks and encouragement to teaching elders and ruling elders. Mr. Lotspeich encouraged service and openness to transformation and renewal. He stated that rather than "ready, aim, fire," maybe we should "ready, fire, aim" more often. He encouraged churches to "go and make disciples."

### Closing Business and Adjournment

The moderator allowed announcements and remarks for Good of the Order. There being no further business to come before the Presbytery, the Stated Clerk moved that the Presbytery stand adjourned until its next stated meeting on November 11, 2017, at Corbin Presbyterian Church, Corbin, KY. Second and motion passed. Moderator Garrod-Logsdon shared words of prayer and blessing. The presbytery adjourned at 2:15 PM.
