Minutes Presbytery of Transylvania Stated Meeting Chapel Hill Presbyterian Church, Lexington, KY November 12,2016

Convening of Presbytery

The annual (stated) meeting of the Presbytery of Transylvania met at Chapel Hill Presbyterian Church, Lexington, KY, on Saturday, November 12, 2016. The meeting began with various workshops at 9:30 AM. At 11:00 AM, the presbytery celebrated worship with a Service of Word and Sacrament. After worship, box lunches were offered and the presbytery heard a presentation on the New Beginnings program. At 1:00 PM, the body gathered in the church sanctuary and the Moderator, ruling elder Peggy Tudor, called the meeting to order. The Moderator opened the meeting with prayer.

Opening Business

A quorum was present. The roll of attendance for this meeting was formed. (see Appendix A) Summary attendance: Teaching elders Present: 45 Churches with elder Commissioner(s) Present: 25 Teaching elders Excused: 11 Churches with elder Commissioner(s) Absent: 51 Teaching elders Absent: 22 Commissioned ruling elders Present: 4 Teaching elders Honorably Retired: 54 Coordinating commission members Present: 3 Presbytery staff Present: 3 Visitors Present: 5

Chapel Hill Clerk of Session Dan Niffenegger welcomed commissioners and guests to the church. The Stated Clerk moved the docket. No new business was presented and the docket was approved. Introductions included first-time teaching elder and ruling elder commissioners and guests. The General Presbyter informed the body of teaching elders who have left the presbytery and/or taken new calls.

The Stated Clerk moved the consent agenda: a) Stated Clerk's report; b) Necrology report; c) Leadership Development Ministry report; d) Congregational Issues commission report; e) Kentucky Council of Churches delegate report. Motion passed.

The body recognized the retirements of teaching elders Janet Prewitt, Phillip Pogue and Katherine Redmond and celebrated their respective ministries. The Moderator led the presbytery in a time of prayer.

The General Presbyter led the body in a generative discussion about the former liaison system and the need for connections between the presbytery, its churches, and its pastors and leaders. The presbytery broke into small groups for discussion and reporting.

Decision Agenda

Mission Ministry

Chair Carol Shutt reported. Grant recipients were recognized.

Administration Commission/Treasurer's Report

Chair David Shaw reported. The commission moved that the 2017 operating budget of \$505,607 and the Burnamwood subsidiary budget of \$262,000 be adopted. Motion passed. The commission moved that the presbytery's portion of per capita be set at \$25.51 per member for 2017. With the synod per capita of \$3.62 and General Assembly per capita of \$7.50, total per capita for 2017 would be \$36.63. Motion passed. The commission moved the distribution of unified mission giving for 2017 be as follows: 78% to Transylvania Presbytery, 17% to General Assembly, and 5% to Synod of Living Waters. Motion passed. In their role as trustees of the presbytery, the commission presented a year-end report.

Coordinating Commission

Teaching Elder Beth Garrod-Logsdon reported for the Coordinating Commission.

The Coordinating Commission moved that the presbytery approve the revised bylaws, with new bylaws to become effective on March 30, 2017.

Teaching elder John White moved an amendment, that section 3.2 E be stricken and replaced as follows: "The Coordinating Commission shall suggest changes to the Manual of Operations, for approval by the Presbytery at its next stated or called meeting." Amendment passed.

Teaching elder Beth Garrod-Logsdon moved that the bylaws be amended: "renumber current section 4 to section 5. Add new section 4: The Administrative Commission. Section 4.1 The Administrative Commission shall be composed of six members. Its duties shall include serving as the Trustees of the Presbytery and having responsibility for Accounting, Budgeting and Staff Services. The Treasurer of the Presbytery shall serve as an advisory member with voice and without vote. Section 4.2 The Administrative Commission shall serve as Trustees for and on behalf of the Presbytery of Transylvania, Inc., a religious corporation. The Corporation shall elect the Process Agent, who is responsible for performance of the duties prescribed by the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky with reference to corporations. The Stated Clerk fills this office and shall also serve as Process Agent for the Trustees. The Trustees are empowered to receive, to hold, to encumber, to manage, and to transfer property, real or personal, for the Presbytery; to accept and to execute deeds of title to such property; to hold and to defend title to such property; to manage any special funds for the furtherance of the purposes of the church, when authorized to do so by the Presbytery. It is the duty of the Trustees to facilitate the management of the civil affairs of the Presbytery in keeping with the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky. The trustees shall report to the Presbytery as necessary or as requested and shall function in accord with the Book of Order." Amendment passed.

No further amendments being presented, the motion to approve the revised bylaws, as amended, passed.

The Coordinating Commission moved that the presbytery approve the revised Manual of Operations, with new manual to become effective on March 30, 2017. Motion passed.

The Coordinating Commission recommends that the Presbytery form a new standing commission, a Commission on Church Closings and Dismissals. This commission would be composed of 5 members, with the responsibilities to be spelled out at the March meeting, and the COR to bring names for election. Motion passed.

The Coordinating Commission adopted the work of the Commission on Representation and brings forward the lists of individuals for various offices within the Presbytery structure. Teaching elder Janet Prewitt, COR chair, placed these names in nomination:

The Commission on Pastoral Transitions moved that the presbytery approve the *Minimum Salary Requirements for Pastoral Positions in the Presbytery Recommended to Presbytery for the Year 2017.* Motion passed.

General Presbyter

Teaching elder Philip Lotspeich reported. Philip's report shared procedural issues (engaging change, system anxiety, destabilization with changes, shared accountability and moving forward in the best ways) and pastoral concerns (tensions from recent national elections, reminders that "God is in charge," how best to work for peace, hope, love, purity).

New Business

The Moderator installed newly-elected Moderator Beth Garrod-Logsdon and offered prayers. General Presbyter Philip Lotspeich honored the retiring moderator and presented gifts.

Closing Business and Adjournment

There being no further business to come before the Presbytery, the Stated Clerk moved that the Presbytery stand adjourned until its next stated meeting on March 14, 2017, at a place to be determined. Second and motion passed. Moderator Garrod-Logsdon Tudor shared words of prayer and blessing. The presbytery adjourned at 4:00 PM.
