Presbytery of Transylvania Stated Meeting

Versailles Presbyterian Church, Versailles, KY

March 14, 2017

Convening of Presbytery

The stated meeting of the Presbytery of Transylvania met at Versailles Presbyterian Church, Versailles, KY, on Tuesday, March 14, 2017. Moderator Beth Garrod-Logsdon opened the meeting at 10:03 AM with prayer. Teaching elder Keith Benze of the host church welcomed the members of the presbytery.

Opening Business

A quorum was present. The roll of attendance for this meeting was formed. (see Appendix A)

The Stated Clerk moved the docket. An item of new business concerning the Lexington Korean Church was introduced, which was added to the docket. The docket was approved

as amended. Introductions included first-time teaching elder and ruling elder commissioners and guests. The General Presbyter informed the body of teaching elders who have left the presbytery and/or taken new calls.

The Stated Clerk moved the consent agenda: a) Stated Clerk's report, with recommendations to approve requests for excused absences, accept resignations from Nik Fegenbush as presbytery treasurer, William Putman from Commission on Congregational Issues, approve the minutes of the November 12, 2016, annual meeting, approve minutes of the installation commission of the Rev. Matt Falco on January 15, 2017, statistical information for the presbytery; b) Mission Ministry report; c) Commission on Congregational Issues report; d) Synod of Living Waters commissioner report. Motion passed.

Decision Agenda

Commission on Preparation for Ministry, part 1

Chair Frank Pottorff. Chair Pottorff introduced inquirer John Kupar, who has expressed a desire to move from inquiry to candidacy status. Mr. Kupar shared remarks. On motion, the presbytery approved John Kupar's move to candidacy. Moderator Garrod-Logsdon offered prayers for Mr. Kupar's ministry journey.

Coordinating Commission

Janet Prewitt reported. The Coordinating Commission recommends the presbytery elect the following: Susan Byars, ruling elder, Mt. Horeb, Commission on Preparation for Ministry, class of 2019; Cynthia Pennington, ruling elder, Second Lex, Commission on Preparation for Ministry, class of 2019; Diehl Ackerman, ruling elder, Faith Morehead, Commission on Representation, class of 2018; Nell Line, ruling elder, First Lex, Coordinating Commission; Tom Burns, ruling elder, Buckhorn Lake, Coordinating Commission; Katie Busroe, ruling elder, Faith Morehead, Coordinating Commission; Mike Ward, teaching elder, Walnut Hill Lex, Coordinating Commission; Linda Maconochie, teaching elder, FPC Paris, Coordinating Commission; Mary Reed, teaching elder, HR, Coordinating Commission. There were no nominees from the floor and those named were elected.

Church Revitalization and Redevelopment Ministry

Chair Jay Mumper reported. Chair Mumper shared news of those churches in the New Beginnings process and introduced Janet Robinson, from FPC, Winchester, who talked about the improv group formed in their church and how it's being used to support the work of the Clark County Homeless Coalition.

Christian Formation

Ginny Baker reported. Mrs. Baker shared resources on curriculum and nurturing Christian education with the POINT program.

Commission on Pastoral Transitions

Chair Lisa Eye and Vice-Chair Darryl Baker reported. Actions taken by the commission were noted. The report was suspended to move to the order of the day.

Order of the Day: Worship

At 11:00 AM, the presbytery moved to worship, which included the Sacrament of Communion. At 11:57 AM, the moderator declared a recess for lunch and offered prayers of blessing for the meal.

Decision Agenda, Continued

At 1:00 PM, the moderator called the presbytery to order. Ms. Abby Drane from Uspiritus brought greetings from her agency and explained the nature of their work and encouraged the presbytery's churches to support it with prayer and site visits.

At 1:05 PM, the moderator recognized retiring presbytery staff member Sharel Templeton. Members of the presbytery offered words of congratulation and the stated clerk spoke prayers to honor Sharel.

Commission on Pastoral Transitions

The report continued. Updated policies on teaching elder membership in the presbytery and criteria for evaluating and approving validated ministries was discussed.

Commission on Preparation for Ministry, part 2

Chair Frank Pottorff presented candidate James Blankenbeker, who has taken a position as staff chaplain at UK Health Care and requests ordination and membership in Transylvania Presbytery. Mr. Blankenbeker made opening statements and the body moved to examine him for ordination. Motion made to sustain the ordination and approve him for ordination. Motion passed. Chair Pottorff offered prayers. At candidate's request, ordination will take place by his home presbytery (Ohio Valley).

Administration Commission/Treasurer's Report

Curtis Christian reported. The commission recommends to the presbytery: that upon the request of the First Presbyterian Church of Pineville, that an administrative commission be formed to dissolve the church, and with the following members: Curtis Christian, chair, teaching elder, FPC Richmond; Margaret Suters, ruling elder, White's Memorial Berea;

Michael Denney, teaching elder, FPC Lancaster; Baylor Fulton, ruling elder, FPC Pineville; and that the administrative commission named be charged to: a. attempt to locate any official records of the church and turn them over to the stated clerk of the presbytery for proper preservation; b. after consulting with the trustees of the presbytery (Administration Commission) recommend to presbytery the disposition of any and all church property and carry out said disposition following approval by the presbytery; c. arrange for certificates of transfer to other churches for current members, if any; and d. prepare and conduct a service of recognition of the life and ministry of FPC Pineville at a stated meeting of the presbytery. Motion passed. The Treasurer's Report for December 31, 2016, was presented as a written report as well as other actions taken by the commission.

Commission for Preparation for Ministry, part 3

Chair Frank Pottorff presented candidate Tamara Schmidt, who has taken a position as chaplain at Baptist Healthcare, Corbin and requests ordination and membership in Transylvania Presbytery. Ms. Schmidt made opening statements and the body moved to examine her for ordination. Motion made to sustain the ordination and approve her for ordination. Motion passed. Chair Pottorff offered prayers. At candidate's request, ordination will take place by her home presbytery (East Iowa).

General Assembly Amendments to Constitution

The stated clerk presented the proposed amendments to the constitution, as suggested by the 222nd General Assembly. General Presbyter Report

Philip Lotspeich reported and spoke thanks to the pastor and members of Versailles Presbyterian Church for their gracious hospitality. The General Presbyter reported on events and activities and reminded the body that our August meeting would take place at Maysville, which is celebrating its 200th anniversary year. The General Presbyter also encouraged the presbytery, sharing his sense that we are in a season of pruning and preparing for new ways to reinvent and do church.

New Business

Teaching elder Lisa Eye moved that an administrative commission be formed to serve as the session of the Lexington Korean Church, until such a time as the church can identify new elders, and those serving as this commission be: teaching elder Lisa Eye (Corbin), teaching elder Jason Santalucia (Hunter), ruling elder William Reed (First Lex), and ruling elder Ginny Baker (Maxwell Street Lex). Motion passed.

Closing Business and Adjournment

The moderator allowed announcements and remarks for Good of the Order. There being no further business to come before the Presbytery, the Stated Clerk moved that the Presbytery stand adjourned until its next stated meeting on August 12, 2017, at First Presbyterian Church, Maysville. Second and motion passed. Moderator Garrod-Logsdon Tudor shared words of prayer and blessing. The presbytery adjourned at 3:15 PM.
