The chart reflects that as of 2/27/18, that of our 77 churches; 17 of them are vacant; that the terms of call for all pastoral leaders serving 20 hours or more (41 leaders serving 38 churches) meet or exceed the 2018 Minimum Terms of Call approved by the Presbytery at its November 2017 meeting.

The Pastoral Transitions Commission is only able to carry out its responsibilities with the help of presbytery leaders who offer their time and skill as session moderators, pulpit supply, and assist with congregational assessment and leader education.
