Minutes of the Stated Meeting of the Presbytery of Transylvania First Presbyterian Church, Winchester, KY January 26,2019

Convening of Presbytery

The stated meeting of the Presbytery of Transylvania met at First Presbyterian Church, Winchester, KY, on Saturday, January 26, 2019. A quorum was present. Moderator Mike Ward called the meeting to order at 10:00 AM and led the opening prayer.

Opening Business

The roll of attendance for this meeting was formed. (see Appendix A)

Teaching elders Present: 38; Teaching Elders Excused: 18; Teaching Elders Absent: 19; Ruling Elder Commissioners Present: 25; Churches with Elder Commissioner(s) Absent: 53; Commissioned Ruling Elders Present: 4; Coordinating Commission members Present: 2; Presbytery Staff: 2; Visitors Present: 4; Corresponding Members Present: 2.

The Stated Clerk moved the docket. Docket approved as printed. First-time commissioners and other guests were recognized. Host pastor Ryan Bradney welcomed the presbytery to Winchester, First Church. General Presbyter Philip Lotspeich informed the body of teaching elders who have left the presbytery and/or taken new calls.

The Stated Clerk moved the consent agenda: a) Stated Clerk's report, with recommendations to approve requests for excused absences; approve the minutes of the November 2-3, 2018, annual meeting, Matthews ordination/installation of November 4, 2018, Bowman Ordination/Installation of November 10, 2018, Warren Installation of November 11, 2018; accept resignations of Steve Pace from Commission on Preparation for Ministry, Brad Marcum from Congregational Issues Commission, and Catesby Woodford from presbytery treasurer; b) KY Council of Churches Delegate report; c) Commission on Preparation for Ministry report; d) Pastoral Transitions Commission report; e) Leadership Development Ministry report. Motion passed.

Board of Pensions Representative Report

Teaching elder Edward Thompson, minister member of Heartland Presbytery, addressed the presbytery, sharing good news of recent initiatives at the Board of Pensions, including programs to reduce educational debt and a new Healthy Pastors/Healthy Congregations effort. Mr. Thompson reminded the body that he's available for questions or concerns and always willing to help with BOP matters.

Generative Discussion

Moderator Ward introduced the yearly theme, *Life Together*, and led the presbytery in a time of small-group discussion and shared reflections. Moderator Ward called a short recess at 10:50 AM to prepare for worship.

Order of the Day: 11:00 AM

The presbytery worshiped together by Word and Sacrament of Communion. At the conclusion of worship, Moderator Ward declared a lunch recess until 1:00 PM.

Coordinating Commission

Teaching elder Philip Lotspeich reported. The commission moved the following 2019 presbytery meeting dates, times, and locations:

The Moderator called on the Stated Clerk to lead a discussion of proposed amendments to the Constitution, as suggested by the 223rd General Assembly. The Moderator appointed David Hoskins, Mary Weese, and Donald Stanley as tellers to count the ballot sheets. After voting, the Moderator announced the results:

Presbyterian Women

Ruling elder Karen May reported. Ms. May talked of the new PW Bible Study, and announced the Spring Gathering planned for Saturday, April 27, 2019, with a theme of issues surrounding human trafficking. Ms. May also informed the body of the PW Synod gathering to take place June 13-15, 2019, in Tupelo, MS. Scholarships are available to help defray costs.

Church Revitalization and Development Ministry

Teaching elder Jay Mumper reported. Mr. Mumper announced that the Phila Group would be leading a Spring Conference on April 4, 2019, and April 6, 2019, at Stanford Presbyterian Church.

Burnamwood Commission

Teaching elder Matt Falco and Camp Director Robby Lear reported. Mr. Lear shared dates for upcoming events: Senior High Retreat Apr 12-14, Middle School Retreat Mar 15-17, and Younger Grades Retreat Apr 26-28. The Bowl-a-Thon will be February 24, 2019. Several groups have already signed up for BAM (Burnamwood Appalachian Ministry) weeks this summer.

Mr. Falco spoke on the commission's consideration of selective logging of the camp property as a way to generate funds. Mr. Falco reported that after consultation and recommendations, the logging to be considered could generate approximately \$75,000, and the commission is looking at ways to best utilize these funds. In consultation with the Administration Commission and Coordinating Commission, the commission plans to bring a full proposal to the next presbytery meeting for consideration. Mr. Falco also spoke of a larger set of initiatives, to engage the camp in meeting the needs of the local Irvine and Estill County community. Mr. Falco encouraged the presbyters to contact him with any questions, concerns, or suggestions as proposals are being developed.

General Presbyter Report

Teaching elder Philip Lotspeich reported. The General Presbyter named the challenges facing our congregations in these days. Mr. Lotspeich encouraged the presbytery to keep speaking out to the world, even when it's risky and difficult. He expressed words of hope and excitement for the journey of this year and all that the presbytery is planning, including ways to connect and communicate better, the development of technology stations to reduce travel and encourage participation, and strengthening our smaller churches. He said, "God often uses the small to accomplish the big."

Closing Business

The Moderator asked for a time of informal announcements. At 2:05 PM, there being no other business before the Presbytery, the Stated Clerk moved that the Presbytery stand adjourned until its next stated meeting on Thursday, March 14, 2019, at Midway Presbyterian Church, Midway. Motion passed. The Moderator spoke a closing prayer.
