

The Temporary Supply will be responsible for providing the pastoral duties as follows:

- Lead the congregation in Sunday morning worship services, providing sacraments for baptism, and communion as authorized by the Session.
- Prepare special services as designated by the Session, including Maundy Thursday and Christmas Candlelight services.
- Provide leadership for the Session as moderator and in pastoral care, Christian education, spiritual development, mission, evangelism, and fellowship as it relates to the congregation.
- Encourage and counsel persons for preparation for membership as provided by the Book of Order.
- Officiate at marriages and funerals as requested and in keeping with the Book of Order.
- Be active in Presbytery within the boundaries of time.

The normal work week will average nineteen (19) hours.

During the length of the agreement, the Supply will be accountable to the Presbytery through the Pastoral Transition Commission and will participate with the Committee and the Session in periodic evaluations of this ministry, and also at the end of the contract.

It is agreed that this Covenant may be terminated upon thirty (30) days written notice by either the Supply or by the Session. If terminated by the Session prior to the end of the Covenant period, compensation will continue for two (2) weeks after the date of termination of ministry.
