As we come up on Memorial Day weekend, I've been thinking about all of the times throughout the scriptures that God's people are called to remembrance.

The word "remember" is used 286 times throughout the Bible. That's a lot of remembering!

In the book of Exodus, God's people are told to "Remember the sabbath day, and keep it holy."

When God's people were in exile, God spoke through the prophet Isaiah and said, "Remember these things, O Jacob, and Israel, for you are my servant; I formed you, you are my servant; O Israel, you will not be forgotten by me."

When Jesus is gathered with his disciples around the Last Supper, he tells them to eat the bread and drink the wine in **remembrance** of him.

After his resurrection, he blesses them to go and baptize all nations and gives them this reminder: "Remember, I am with you always, even to the ends of the age."

Time and again through scripture we are called to remember as God's people.

We're called to remember who God is and what God has done for us.

As we prepare to celebrate Memorial Day this weekend, we remember.

We remember those who died while serving in the military.

We remember their families in prayer.

We remember that we have been gifted this world by our ancestors and we are borrowing this world from our children.

We remember that we do not belong only to ourselves, but that we are connected to something bigger than us. We're connected to one another in the family of God as we're continually called to remember, time and again.

And in doing so, we are re-membered. We are rejoined to the body of Christ as God continually knits us together in community with one another for the sake of the world.
