

INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY

CHC's policy regarding postponements and closures due to inclement weather is to provide for the safety of all visitors, parishioners, and staff. It takes into consideration not only the conditions being reported, but the time it takes to clear the premises, sidewalks, and parking lot to create a safe traveling environment.

Inclement Weather: Methods of Communication

The office will post the building's status on the CHC website and Facebook page, and an announcement will be placed on the parish office's voice mail system at 410-252-2711.

Sunday Services

Every effort will be made to maintain our **regular worship schedule**. Closings will be posted by 7:00 a.m. for Sunday services. Please take note of your personal situation in terms of whether or not it is safe or prudent for you to travel and decide accordingly whether or not to attend. If you are scheduled to serve, please likewise only come in if it is safe and prudent for you to do so. Be aware that programs like the Nursery and Church School may have limitations due to staffing, if teachers cannot make it.

Parish Office, Church Meetings, Rehearsals & Outside Groups (KHL and Dove House Counselors excepted)

CHC will follow the Baltimore County School system inclement weather policy.

- o If school is delayed in the morning, all morning activities will be canceled and the office will be open by 11:00 a.m.
- o If school is dismissed early, all evening activities will be canceled; and the office will close early.
- o If school is closed for the day, all activities will be canceled for the day and the office will be closed.

Special Events: Special Services, Funerals, Weddings, Concerts

Special events will be considered on a case by case basis, and schedule changes will be posted on the CHC website and Facebook page and recorded on the parish office voice mail system.
